Then, overlooking the breathtaking Amalfi Bay, learn the art of traditional pasta making as you prepare the dough and shape it into the distinctive cylinders that made this recipe famous. Guided by the Chef, you will create your own cannelloni filled with beef and tomato before sitting down to enjoy the dish you have prepared, accompanied by the unique atmosphere and panoramic views of the Amalfi Coast.
