Pet policy

## PETS ALLOWED

- . Dogs and cats only
- . Max. 25 Kg
- . A maximum of 2 pets per room

## INCLUSIONS

- . Pet bed and mat
- . Bowls for water and food
- . For cats, a litter tray and sand
- . Welcome kit

## RATES

50 EUR per pet per night

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

- . Pets can be left alone in the room when making use of a kennel. When a pet is left in the room, we do not provide housekeeping services.
- . It is important that guests supply the Front Office team with their contact number should it be required.
- . Housekeeping will not clean the room when the pet is there alone, so guests must agree to the cleaning hours for the length of their stay.
- . When the guest leaves the pet alone in the room, a specific pet hanger is required to be hung on the exterior handle of the guestroom door to indicate that the pet is alone.
- . Pets are not allowed to be in the common food and beverage areas of the hotel (bars, restaurants, breakfast areas).
- . The use of a dog leash is mandatory in common areas of the hotel.
- . Any damage caused by the animal will be the responsibility of the owner and a charge will be made to the credit card for the replacement of the damaged object.
- . In case of noise or inconvenience caused by the pet, the hotel reserves the right to cancel the reservation of the guest.
- . Pets are not allowed to use the bath, showers, towels or sheets in the rooms.
- . Owners should provide the necessary food and hygiene products for their pet's stay, with the exception of the items mentioned above in the inclusions section.

## MAIN LOCAL REGULATIONS ABOUT DOGS IN PUBLIC AREAS

- . Keep your dog on a leash at all times, in pedestrian zones and on streets with heavy pedestrian traffic as well as in public buildings or on public transport.
- . Restricted breeds are required to wear a muzzle and be kept on a short strong lead (under two metres).
- . The above does not apply to designated dog exercise areas.
- . Dog owners are obliged by law to pick up their dog's faeces and dispose of it in a public litter bin. Failure to do so may incur a penalty fee.
- . Before visiting a public place or attraction, please check their respective website, the city's service centre or tourist information points to find out if dogs are allowed.
